Prior to the fire, the Board received several complaints regarding usage of the Club by non-members. Our Guest Policies are laid out in the House Rules – currently at page 4. Specifically, our House Rules state that in-town guests (residents of Harrison and Jackson County) may not be brought to the club on a recurring basis. When the Club fully reopens, we will be committed to enforcing the House Rules.

In addition to enforcing the House Rules, the Board has recently formed an ad hoc House Rules committee to review and propose changes to the existing House Rules. have had a few members ask about sail camp dates, registration will open March 1st, but for those of you that are planning ahead I wanted to put out a preliminary schedule for sail camp:

5/28-5/31 - Adventure Camp  
6/3-6/14 - Two week camp  
6/17-6/28 - Two week camp  
7/1-7/12 - Two week camp  
7/15-7/19 - Adventure camp  
7/22-7/26 - Race camp

If you have any questions about Sail Camp this summer please don't hesitate to reach out to me regarding any of the camps. Last year we had multiple parents asking for an adult camp; if you are interested in learning to sail, please let me know so that we can plan a camp for adults that could meet a few late afternoons during the summer.

Greetings OSYC'ers!

We would like to thank everyone who has logged onto our new private website and registered their payment information. While we have made significant progress, we still have a ways to go.

I've often been asked the question whether OSYC will still accept paper checks and/or cash for monthly statement payments. The answer is yes. We want to facilitate this process.

Since the implementation of our new software system on December 1<sup>st</sup>, we are getting a much better grasp of member payments, as well as non-payments. At our recent Board meeting, it was concluded that we will aggressively take action and regarding aging and delinquent accounts.

Now that we are through the transition period with the new software, we will make it a priority in following the rules regarding past due accounts.

**Beginning February 2<sup>nd</sup>, here are the guidelines we will follow:**

**30 days delinquent-charging privileges suspended**

**60 days delinquent-suspended from all club activities**

**90 days delinquent-collections and revocation of membership**

While we do not want to lose any members, we also want to enforce the existing rules in place.
