2024 Catamaran Racing Season Begins at the Ocean Springs Yacht Club

April is the beginning of the 2024 catamaran racing season here at the OSYC. We hope you will come by the Club to participate as a spectator during these two regattas; bring your binoculars along for a great view of the sailing from the deck. The two regattas that will be taking place this week are:

(1) the Hobie 14 Nationals Regatta

The official notices of races, a current list of competitors, and sailing instructions are all available at the Regatta Network links provided above. These are the first of the year regattas for your Club, which is one of the premiere locations for catamaran racing in the United States.

As of the writing of this newsletter, there are 30 sailors registered for the Hobie 14 NAC event, and 91 boats, each with one to two competitors on board, signed up to sail in the April Fools Regatta.

One participant in both the Hobie NAC event and the April Fools Regatta is Joseph Bennett, coming all the way from Lefkas, Greece. He has over 33,000 subscribers on his You Tube channel JoyriderTV. The Ocean Springs Sailing Squadron is pleased to have him as a guest, and hopes that you will come out to watch him sail!

Our second April regatta was formerly known as the Hobie Mid-Winters East. It is open to Hobie one-design classes including Waves, Hobie 14, Hobie 16, Hobie 17, Hobie 18 and Hobie 20 catamarans,

plus the Formula Wave class, Youth Wave class, and an Open Multihull Class.

Past competitors for the Midwinters have traveled from Ottawa (Ontario, Canada), New York State, Iowa, South Carolina, Florida, Tennessee, Texas, Alabama, Colorado, Delaware, Illinois, Louisiana, Mississippi, New Jersey, Oklahoma, Rhode Island, and Wyoming. The regatta consists of three days of intense buoy racing off the OSYC beach mixed in with other activities at the Club. Racing will take place on a course in the waters of Biloxi Bay out in front of the Ocean Springs Yacht Club, with boats leaving from the beach in front of the OSYC.

Again, copies of the Notices Of Race (NOR) and sailing instructions for both of the regattas are available at the links provided earlier. Both of these contain information that will help you to follow the racing out on the water.
